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Renaissance (Accelerated Reader) AR Friends





Early Readers - Grades K-2

Students earn tokens and badges based on passed guizzes. Teachers set these yearly goals based on book level and expected daily reading time and see progress in a corresponding record book. The fun Accelerated Reader Friend character badges keep students excited to read and achieve their reading goals.



Progress on reading goals is presented to students in an easy-tounderstand dashboard that illustrates average % correct, average book level, and points earned. Students will be able to determine next steps to meet or maintain their goal with their progress page.

Lexia Core5

Grades Pre K - 5th

Lexia Core5 Reading is an interactive computer based program designed to help students master foundational reading skills through continuous assessment that will help with reading success.



Grades Pre-K - 5th

Lexia English is an adaptive blended learning speaking and listening program that supports English language through academic conversations.



Grades K - 5th

Exact Path is a digital tool that personalizes learning across grades K-12 in reading, language arts, and math. It starts by targeting each child's academic strengths and weaknesses with an adaptive assessment, and then prescribes a tailored learning path of lessons, practice, and assessment based on specific strengths and needs. Your child will be using this program at school, but they can also continue learning at home.

Reflex Math is a quick math facts practice program. It is a daily expectation for 1st - 5th graders to try getting a "green light".




Frax Math is a quick fraction fluency practice program that is connected to Reflex. This is for 3rd - 5th graders.

- Math homework will be given daily Monday through Thursday almost regularly. There may be occasions that they don't have homework.

Grading Expectations

- Grading Scale:
 - A = 90% 100%
 - B = 80% 89%
 - C = 70% 79%
 - D = 60 69%
 - F = 59% or below
- **Formative** assessments occur during the instructional process and guide teaching and learning. (10%)
- **Summative** assessments are the final opportunity for students to show mastery of benchmarks before moving on to new skills. (90%)
- Students can retake Summative assessments after all formative assessments are completed and focused reteaching and practice has occurred.
